Dear Neighbor,

I would like to first thank our 10- Year Committee members for their hard work and for providing recommendations to the Board of Directors for the 2023 budget year. At the last Board meeting held on Monday, September 12, 2022, the Board of Directors voted on a budget and capital improvement items.

The 10-Year Committee recommended safety and infrastructure as pressing needs for the community. The committee believed the items below should be the focus of the first year of capital improvements:

- 1. Amenity sidewalks should be replaced to meet the needs of the community.
- 2. Repair and replace the parking lot within the amenity area.
- 3. Installing lights in the amenity area.

The Board of Directors voted unanimously to accept the recommendation and budget \$100,000 for these projects. We have requested the Property Manager to create the scope of work and begin the bidding process. We are excited to get these projects completed. If you are interested in bidding or providing expertise on these projects, don't hesitate to contact our Property Manager (Mark, <u>cehapm@gmail.com</u>) to obtain any details.

In addition, the Board of Directors drafted a budget that provided necessary increases to certain budget line items for meeting our obligation to provide services to our community. As we all have experienced, prices only go up from material, labor, and services. Therefore, the Board of Directors voted unanimously to increase the annual assessment by \$30.00 (\$2.50 per month extra) for the 2023 budget year. We feel this is in the best interest of the Association to meet current and future obligations. In the following months, you will receive notices of the Board of Directors budget and an invitation to our membership meeting. Please be on the lookout, and we hope you can join us.

We are excited to announce that we will host a **Fall Festival** on **November 12, 2022**, at the amenity center. The goal is to have food trucks, music, and a Food Drive to benefit local families within Churchill High School. We will be advertising shortly, and if you are willing to volunteer to help plan the event, don't hesitate to contact our Administrator at <u>churchillestaetshoa@gmail.com</u>. *Cheers to the cooler weather!*

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
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THE HOUSING SHORTAGE

Gates at Churchill Annual Meeting

Speeding and Traffic Safety in the Gates

Now that school has started, it's time to remind all motorists in our community to drive slowly, obey the 20-mph speed limit, and watch out for pedestrians, children, and bicyclists. To be good neighbors, it is essential that we all drive slow and obey traffic laws. The speed limit in the Gates at Churchill is 20 mph. Exceeding the posted speed limit increases the risk of an accident and puts pedestrians, bicyclists and other vehicles in danger. Driving too



fast also reduces control over steering the vehicle and increases the time it takes to slow down and stop. The narrow roads in our community requires all drivers to slow down and remain alert. Safety is a shared responsibility.

Camara Upgrades at the Gates

New camera systems have been installed at the Triple Crown and Snip gates. Four cameras, two on each side, were installed at the Triple Crown gate, and two cameras, one on each side, were installed at the gate on Snip. Before the upgrade, the Snip gate was not equipped with cameras. Both camera systems have night vision capabilities.

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








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
