



Tips for Saving Energy in San Antonio This Summer

Spring is nice for a couple reasons: flowers start to bloom; you can crack windows for fresh air and your energy bill is commonly at its most economical. That's because you're not relying on your heat or air conditioner.

- Keep blinds closed—Sunlight quickly transforms into heat as it passes through windows. Keep your house more comfortable by shutting blinds and curtains when you're not staying in sunny spaces.

Smart thermostats figure out your routine and move the temp when you're out and about to help you save money. You can also adjust the temp from anywhere with your phone.

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D9 Updates

San Antonio International Airport Expansion

San Antonio International Airport was founded in 1941 when the City of San Antonio purchased 1,200 acres of undeveloped land that was then north of the city limits. The airport opened in July 1942 as Alamo Field and was used by the United States Army Air Forces as a training base. At the end of the war the airfield was no longer needed by the military and was turned over to the City of San Antonio for civil use.

As airport passenger traffic grew over the years, master plans were developed in 1975, 1994, 2010 and 2021 to identify growth needs. The latest master plan is intended to provide for passenger traffic through 2040 when 14.5 million passengers are expected annually.

The current master plan has two main phases. The first phase focuses on growth needs for passengers and includes constructing a new passenger terminal and parking garage to be completed by 2028. The second phase focuses on growth needs for increased aircraft operations and includes runway modifications in both short and longer terms.

The new passenger terminal will add 17 new passenger gates and consolidate airline ticket counters and passenger screening, into single locations. The layout will permit free flow of passengers

between all gates. The new terminal will more than double the square footage of the two existing terminals. Approximately 600 additional feet of curb space will be added for both departures and arrivals. The architectural design of the new terminal will highlight a natural walkway that highlights the story of San Antonio's creeks and springs. The additional parking garage will include a ground transportation center.

The second phase of the master plan involves runway modifications needed to accommodate the increase in aircraft flights through 2040. The near-term modification involves installing high speed offramps on the main southeast-northwest runway. This will allow landing aircraft to more quickly exit the runway and thus allow landing aircraft to be more closely spaced. The longerterm modifications involve three elements. First is lengthening the shorter southeast-northwest parallel runway to accommodate commercial passenger aircraft. Second is abandoning the current north-south runway. And third is lengthening the main southeastnorthwest parallel runway to 10,000 feet to permit commercial passenger aircraft to fly directly to eastern Europe destinations. The noise exposure map will be updated as part of planning the runway modifications One effect of these runway changes is that all aircraft traffic at San Antonio International Airport will fly over Churchill Estates either on landing or takeoff.

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Entry Gate Security Management

The entry gate in our community provides an additional layer of security that benefits all residents. For this reason, it is critical that residents do not share their gate code with others nor post their code on the gate entry key pad. Homeowners can obtain a temporary gate code that can activated for a specific time period by contacting CIA Services. For example, if a homeowner is planning to have a birthday party, garage sale or other event at their home, CIA Services can issue a temporary gate code.

To request a temporary gate code, the homeowner must call or send an email message to CIA Services. Homeowners can also use the Ask-Request-Submit function on the CIA Services website. When requesting a temporary gate code, be sure to specify the start and end dates needed for the code. After CIA Services processes the request, the temporary gate code will be emailed to the homeowner. Gate codes and temporary gates codes are issued to homeowners only. CIA Services will not issue new or temporary gate codes to tenants.

Gates at Churchill Estates Parking and Towing Policy

The Board of Directors has completed a policy that establishes rules for vehicle parking on our streets. The policy, which is part of our governing documents, grants the Board authority to tow vehicles, at the owner's expense, that are improperly parked. The policy also prohibits vehicle parking in various restricted areas such as near the gates, by stop signs, along red curbs and by mailboxes. A copy of the policy is available on the CIA Services website.

Update on Google Fiber Contract

The Board of Directors recently completed a review of the contract with Google for the installation of Google Fiber in our community. The Board is now waiting on the final copy of the contract. Once complete, the HOA Board will make the contact available to homeowners and conduct a town hall meeting to respond to questions and concerns from homeowners. The Board will then vote on the contract. Once approved, Google will then bring their services to our community.


Reminders for Churchill Estates Dog Owners


