

ROAD RULES FOR DRIVERS

<u>Speed Limit</u>: The posted speed limit on the streets in the Gates at Churchill is 20 MPH. Driving over the posted speed limit is a violation that puts other drivers and pedestrians in danger.

<u>Stop Signs</u>: Do not run the stop signs in the Gates of Churchill. Come to a complete stop before proceeding through the intersection. Rolling through the intersection or failing to stop is unacceptable.

<u>Pedestrians and children</u>: Watch out for children who may be playing in or near the street. Watch out for people walking in the evenings. Also, when walking in the evening or before dawn, wear light-colored clothing or carry a flashlight to alert drivers.

<u>Speed Bumps</u>: The HOA Board of Directors is preparing to have the speed bumps (or speed humps) re-installed on sections of Triple Crown and Preakness Ln. The traffic calming devices were removed temporarily last April when the roads were repaved. The purpose of the speed bumps are to force drivers to slow down and to make our roads safer for all residents.
