

Real Fruit Popsicles Recipe

Ingredients: Choose your flavor

Banana Blueberry = 1 cup banana, 2.5 cups blueberries

<u>Strawberry</u> = 3.5 cups sliced strawberries Banana Kale = 3 cups banana chunks, 1/2 cup fresh kale

- Mango = 3.5 cups mango, diced
- 3.5 cups coconut water
- 2 tablespoons honey (optional)

Directions:

- 1. Place ingredients in a blender and blend until smooth
- 2. Pour into popsicle molds and freeze for 4 hours or overnight.
- 3. Put under hot water to release popsicles from mold, enjoy!
- 4. Simply adjust the amounts depending on the volume of popsicle molds you have on hand. Use equal parts of fruit (fresh or frozen) with coconut water- it's that easy. You can also choose to add a touch of honey if desired

Parked Car Reminders

A few friendly reminders about parking on public streets in San Antonio (taken from COSA website):



Y

The State law requires any vehicle stopped or parked on any public street to be facing

the flow of traffic. This violation occurs more often while parked in front of your residence. In addition, the following is a partial listing of where it is illegal to park:

- in an intersection, on a sidewalk, crosswalk (marked or unmarked), or railroad track;
- in front of any driveway;
- within 15 ft of a fire hydrant;
- within 20 ft of a crosswalk (marked or unmarked);
- within 30 ft of a yield sign, stop sign, or traffic signal;
- double parking on a street.

To report a vehicle parked in the street illegally, please call non-emergency police at (210) 207-7273.

Airplane Noise Bothering You?

Call the San Antonio Airport Noise Mitigation Office at 210/207-3471 to report low or loud aircraft flying over your Churchill Estates residence. Provide your name, address, phone number and time of day the airplane was observed.

1. Trailers, RVs and Boats – If you own a trailer, RV or boat, remember that they are not to be parked in the driveway, street or yard.



- 2. Pets Enjoy walking the neighborhood with your pet, but be sure to clean up after them.
- 3. Yard trimmings Be sure to dispose of clippings properly. Clippings are not to be blown into the street or into neighbor's yards.
- 4. **Trash Receptacles** – Trash cans should be stored out of sight after their designated pick up day. You can place inside your garage or behind a fence. Your neighbors will appreciate it!




5. Driver Safety – Be sure to watch your speed in the neighborhood, and be sure to not exceed 30 miles per hour. Come to complete stops at stop signs and save texting for when you are home safely.

BRUSH COLLECTION WEEK

The twice-annual brush collection week for our community is scheduled for **July 17, 2023**. Residents can expect to receive a flyer from the City on the week before the scheduled brush pick up. Brush should be placed within eight feet



of the curb and ready for pickup no later than <u>7:00 AM</u> on the Monday of the scheduled collection week. Brush piles should not exceed eight cubic yards and should not be placed in front of parked cars or under low-hanging tree limbs.

GOOGLE FIBER TOWN HALL MEETING

On June 4th, the Gates at Churchill Board of Directors held a town hall meeting that gave homeowners an opportunity to ask questions and voice their concerns about the contract with Google Fiber. The Board is expected to vote on the issue at the next Board meeting. If approved, Google will start offering their services to homes in the community. The timeframe for when the service can be ordered is not yet known. A copy of the contract is posted on the CIA Services website.

UPDATE ON NEWLY-APPROVED POLICIES

The Parking and Towing Policy, which was announced in the May 2023 newsletter, has now been posted on the CIA Services website. The policy, which is part of our governing documents, grants the Board authority to tow vehicles, at the owner's expense, that are improperly parked. The policy also prohibits parking in various areas such as near the gates, by stop signs and by mailboxes.

The Board of Directors also completed a new Monitoring Camera Policy for our community. The camera policy defines the usage, access and storage of images collected by the cameras.

STAY SAFE IN THE SUMMER HEAT

NEVER LEAVE YOUR CHILD ALONE IN A CAR

Don't risk your child's life by leaving them in the car. A child's body can heat up five times faster than an adult's and even in cooler weather, cars can heat up to dangerous temperatures very quickly. On a mild day, the temperature inside a car can rise 20 degrees above the outside temperature in just 10 minutes or less.



- Make a habit of checking your vehicle before leaving it. Look before you lock!
- Keep a stuffed animal or other reminders next to you in the car as a cue that your child is with you.
- If you ever see a child alone in a car, dial 9-1-1 immediately!

DON'T FORGET OUR FURRY FRIENDS

Pets can get dehydrated quickly, so make sure you take precautions to keep your pet safe.



- Give your pet plenty of water when it's hot outdoors. Make sure to fill their water bowl before you leave.
- Make sure they have a shady place to get out of the sun.
- Be careful not to over-exercise your pet. Too much playtime in the hot sun is dangerous for them.
- Hot asphalt and tar can burn sensitive paw pads, walk your pet on grass or dirt when possible.
- Keep your pet indoors when it's extremely hot outside.
- Never leave your pet in a car! Pets can overheat in minutes so don't put them at risk! Leave them home during hot weather.
